## Preparing the deployment/installation of your integration

### Important note regarding the deployment of the Genetec products

There are currently two ways of deploying Genetec products, such as the Security Center unified platform:

- **On-premises:** Installed directly at the customer site and not managed by Genetec.
- **On hosted systems:** Deployed on the cloud and is managed by Genetec.

When integrating with a hosted system, it is critical to know that the SDK & API integration cannot be installed/deployed on that system.

The only ways to connect the integration to the hosted system will be through the usage of the Web-based SDK or by deploying/installing the integration on a machine that is not part of the hosted system. The integration would then connect to the hosted system through a standard socket.




*Security center 5.12 or 5.13 with admin access to Genetec security desk and config tool*

*After launching the setup application select next to process with the installer*




*Wait for setup to complete*

## Deploying/installing/ the SDK & API integration


After downloading the AMG-Network device management integration packages locate and run the setup.exe included in the package

## Upgrading the SDK & API integration

Not applicable currently as this is a version 1 installation so there is no upgrade.

## Uninstalling the SDK & API integration

1. Select the setup.exe from the installation package and select remove AMGWorkspace from the options in the install wizard (note please remove all AMG entities from genetec prior to completing uninstallation of the integration to prevent orphaned entities)



Select finish and once complete the integration will be removed from the GSC deployment.
